

"FROM MAO TO MARY"



As a part of First Friday events, May 4, 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., the public is invited to First Presbyterian Church, 121 W. 9th Street, for a showing of Biblical works of renowned Chinese art-

ist He Qi (pronounced Huh Chee). He Qi is an internationally-recognized artist whose distinctive style blends traditional Chinese material and methods with unique interpretations of classic Christian stories.

He Qi came of age during the Cultural Revolution of 1970's China and learned to paint by copying portraits of Chairman Mao. He later began copying Raphael's "Madonna and Child," but in secret. Such diversity of influences remains evident in his work, which has been described as "Chagall meets Matisse meets Picasso meets the East." His art has been displayed throughout Europe, Asia, and North America.

Join us in viewing sixteen of He Qi's paintings—a reinterpretation of sacred art within an ancient Chinese art idiom. (There is a poster outside St. John's main office which shows one of He Qi's works.)
