WHAT IS EPIPHANY?

Today we celebrated Epiphany, which is the 12th day of Christmas and marks the official end to this festive season for many Christians.

The word 'Epiphany' comes from Greek and means "manifestation." It celebrates "the revelation of God in His Son as human in Jesus Christ."

It is associated with the visit of the Magi (the three kings) to Bethlehem.

According to the Gospel of Matthew, the three wise men followed the star of Bethlehem across the desert to meet the baby Jesus, offering gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

These gifts were symbolic of the importance of Jesus' birth, the gold representing His royal standing; the frankincense His divine birth: and myrrh His mortality.
