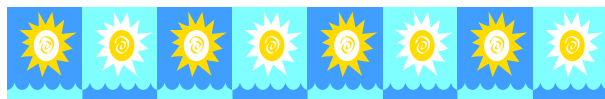

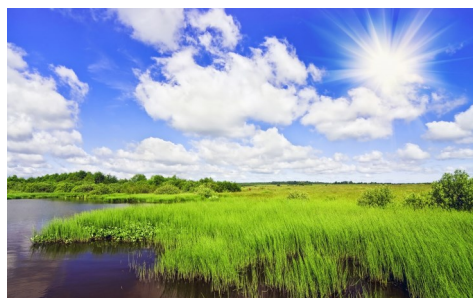


### ~ VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL ~ REGISTRATION
