WOMEN'S STUDY





Camp Millhouse is a non-profit, residential summer camp for children and adults with varying disabilities. The campers come from all across the country for the unique opportunities that Camp Millhouse provides. Our own Pastor Carroll is a past camper and is currently serving on their Board of Directors. Pastor Carroll is a wealth of information on the camp, please speak with him if you would like more detailed information about the camp.

On December 22, 2017, thanks to a lot of community support, Camp Millhouse was able to purchase the property they have called home since 1940. Some of the improvements they would like are to insulate all cabins and move toward central air conditioning, new roofs on many buildings, sidewalk repairs, lots of painting, upgrade all cabin bathrooms, kitchen improvements including a new sanitizer, ice machine, and replace dishes. A new healthcare center will be located in the middle of camp, with a new cabin for campers and staff, a picnic pavillion, a fully-accessible tree house & a zip line, and a splash pad.
